Due to the limited number of spaces, the process below has been implemented.

Payment is required immediately on confirmation of a place being available.

Process

1. Entry Made on Google Forms
2. Email sent offering a space if available within 48hrs
3. Archer required to make immediate payment for the round.
4. If payment if not received within 24hrs from the time of space allocation email the entry will be considered void.
5. Payments received after the 24hr window from the time of the space allocation email . The archer will be contacted for refund details and the space will be offered to the next archer on the waiting list.

Should the event become full a waiting list will be available.

Tents – There are a limited number of tent space available on a first come first served basis. Please share tents with other archers where possible.

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Bosses: Damage / Foam on H Frames

Rules: 6 arrows ends, 2 ends of practice: Alternating AB/CD throughout
AGB / WA Rules Archery GB dress regulations will apply.
Music will be played during the event.

Awards: Top 3 places in each eligible age category

Divisions: Compound, Recurve, Longbow & Barebow

Classes: Open: Over 50, Senior, U21, U18
Women: Over 50, Senior, U21, U18
Age categories are based on your year of birth.

An archer may compete in a junior age group where the Tournament takes place up to and in the year of their birthday prior to the limit on the category. (e.g., if they turned 17 in a year, they could compete in an U18 category, but they cannot turn 18 in the year)

Juniors must be accompanied by an adult.

TO reserves the right to combine classes depending on entries.
