Technical Aspects of the Competition

1. Number of Participants per category

2. Competition Programme

The latest competition programme will be provided 1 week before official practice on the Ianseo website. Any official competition schedule will have indicated the version number and the date/hour it was printed. The latest version of the Competition Schedule at the moment of writing the Team Managers Booklet is V1.0

3. Accreditations

- Accreditation cards may be collected 1 day before the start of the competition from the Information Desk located at the main entrance of the facility.
- Each accreditation card will contain one barcode and one QR code. The barcode on the back of the accreditation card will be used for the main field entrance, while the QR code on the front of the card will be used for access to the Field of Play.

4. Practice

4.1. Training

The training range will be at the Mete Gazoz Archery Facility at Beykoz, Istanbul, which is 45 minutes away from the official hotels. The shuttle service will be available from Avantgarde Urban Taksim Hotel to the practice range.

Range will be available from the 3rd of June 2026 as follows:

3 rd of June	10:00 - 15:00 (Only Recurve)
4 th of June	10:00 - 15:00 (Only Compound)
5 th of June	10:00 – 15:00

Additionally, warm-up targets will be available on the lower level of the competition venue at a distance of 5 meters.

Lunch will **NOT** be served at the practice field. However, lunch will be available at the restaurant next to the practice range at an additional cost.



4.2. Official Practice

3 June 2026 – 09:00 – 09:45 – CM + CW

4 June 2026 – 09:00 – 09:45 – RM + RW

4.3. Qualification Round Warm-Up

There will be no warm-up ends before the qualification rounds, as the official practice will take place immediately beforehand..

Non-competing athletes can use the practice field.

5. Equipment Inspection

- Equipment inspection will be conducted on a random basis during the official practice.
- During the qualification rounds, judges may conduct equipment inspections at random or whenever they deem necessary.
- All teams must wear their uniforms and must have their valid Accreditation Card.
- Spare equipment must also be brought for inspection.
- Team Managers are to check the details of their athletes, such as name and date of birth, are correct beforehand.
- Inform the Judge if details are not correct, and the Judge will inform the Results Team for an update.
- Instructions to use the tablet scoring system will be provided if requested.

6. Athlete (Back) Numbers

Athlete numbers will be issued on the day of the qualification round (with the scorecards) during official practice.

Athlete numbers must be worn on the quiver or thigh, facing the waiting line while shooting.

7. Qualification Round and Information on Scoring

3 June 2026 → 10:00 – 12:45 – CM + CW

4 June 2026 → 10:00 – 12:45 – RM + RW

4 athletes per target in AB – CD Format

720 Round – 70m / 122cm Face for Recurve and 50m / 80cm Face for Compound.

Electronic score terminals (PDAs) and score sheets for each target will be distributed shortly before the start of the qualification rounds.



8. Individual Eliminations

Byes are permitted. In case of a bye, the athlete may be allowed to shoot on their own target.

No scores will be recorded and displayed, and the athletes shooting their byes must respect the DOS timing and signals of competition. Recurve athletes are permitted to shoot 3 sets of practice, and compound athletes are permitted to shoot 5 ends of practice for their bye.

Target faces will **NOT** be changed after practice arrows. Please instruct your athletes to mark all arrow holes during the practice and their byes.

The starting times of sessions and the scheduled times for the practice will be respected, but the matches will continue as soon as the field of play is ready for the next round. Proceeding matches will follow up immediately after the prior match.

Individual Elimination rounds will start at the 1/48 elimination stage. (104 athletes in each category or fewer, depending on entries)

There will be no alternate shooting until medal matches for each category.

8.1. Recurve Elimination

The Set System will be used for all individual and team matches.

Individual matches will consist of the best of 5 sets (3 arrows per set), and the winner is the athlete to reach a minimum of 6 set points first.

The Team matches will consist of the best of 4 sets (6 arrows per set). The team that reaches a minimum of 5 set points first will win the match. All team matches, including finals, will be simultaneously on the FoP.

8.2. Compound Elimination

Matches for all compound events will use the cumulative scoring, consisting of 5 ends of 3 arrows. All individual matches up to medal matches and all the team matches, including finals, will be shot simultaneously at the FoP.

9. Team Elimination

Team eliminations will be held between national teams. Club archers are not eligible to compete in team matches.

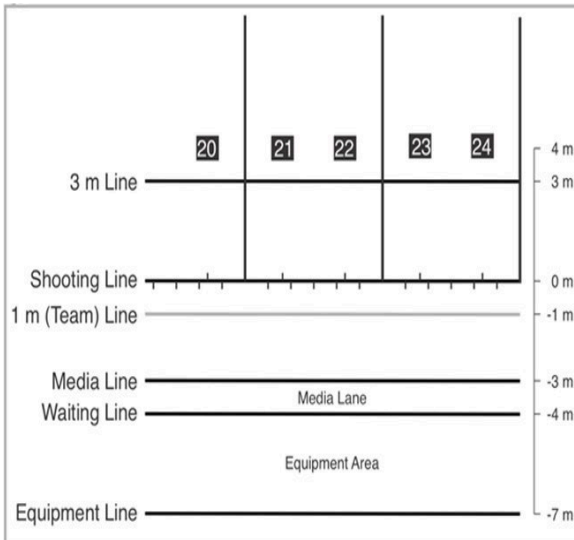
10. Appeal Procedure

In case of an appeal, the Appeal Form should be given to the Chairperson of Judges or his/her deputy.

To proceed with an appeal, a deposit of 50 Euros should be given to the TD or Chairperson of Judges for the appeal to be valid.

If the appeal is upheld by the Jury of Appeal, the **appeal fee will be refunded**. If the appeal is rejected, the **appeal fee will not be refunded**.

11. Lines



A waiting line will be marked at least 4 meters behind the shooting line. A media line will be marked one meter in front of the waiting line. An Equipment/Coaches line will be marked 3 meters behind the waiting line.

For Team rounds, coaches will be permitted to stand in front of the coach line and remain with their team. However, only one scope per team (including the coach) will be allowed in the area between the shooting line and the coach line. If the team wishes to use one scope for the athletes and another for the coach, the coach must remain behind the coach's line.

12. Timing Control System

The local timing control system will be used for timing and scoreboards.

13. Results System

- **Qualification Round:** Scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete records the scores of all other athletes on that target on the official paper-based score sheet. At the same time, another athlete, on the same target, will enter all scores of the athletes on that target into the scoring tablet. The other athletes should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly.
- Scorecards **MUST** be signed by both athlete and scorer, have all the total mathematically correct, with the X's and 10's count fully completed. Any scorecards where the X's and 10's count are not completed, a "0" will be given for the total of X's and 10's count for that athlete.
- **Elimination Round:** Scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete/team records the arrow values of both athletes/teams on the paper score sheet. While at the same time, the other athlete/team inputs the arrow values into the scoring tablet. Both athletes/teams should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly before returning to the shooting line.
- During the **Team** and **Mixed Team** matches, **the score sheets and scoring tablets** will include A-B-C identifiers for each athlete in the team. When recording scores, each arrow must be matched to the corresponding athlete. Examples of the score sheets are attached to this document.
- At the end of the match, the scorecard must be fully completed and signed by the athletes (or agent/judge in the case of finals) involved in the match.
- Scoring tablets will be used during the Qualification and Elimination Rounds, but not in the Finals.
- **Important Note:** There will be internet access on the field of play and in official hotels. Because of this, any information and results won't be distributed as printed. All the information will be published on the official WA website and Ianseio.



Logistic Aspects

1. Transportation

The shuttle service will be available from Avantgarde Urban Taksim Hotel to the competition and practice venue only. The schedule will be published on the official event page and Ianseo. Also attached to this file.

Avantgarde Urban Taksim Hotel will serve as the shuttle point for all official hotels. All other official hotels are within a 2-minute walking distance of the shuttle point.

Athletes will not be permitted to board the shuttle with their equipment. All equipment must be placed in bow cases and stored in the luggage compartment.

2. Meals during the event

Breakfast will be served at the official hotel restaurants, and lunch will be served at the competition field. Dinner will not be served during the event except on the day of the opening ceremony. Dinner will be available at the hotel restaurants at an additional cost.

Protocol and Ceremonies

1. Medal Ceremonies

- All award ceremonies, including the team award ceremonies, will take place after all medal matches are completed.

Medical Related Issues (Emergencies)

1. Medical Services

- First Aid services will be available during the official training and competition days.
- A Paramedic and a nurse will be available on site for any emergencies.

2. Physiotherapy Services

There will be a physiotherapy room at the venue, and all teams are invited to use it with their own physiotherapist.

Clean Sport

1. Anti-Doping Control

- There will be Anti-Doping control according to World Ranking Event and World Archery rules.
- Athletes should bring their passports and/or accreditation cards to the anti-doping control station if selected for a test.
- All participants are expected to comply with World Archery clean sport regulations and standards throughout the event.

Dress Regulation

- Athletes, officials, and staff should wear the appropriate clothing with the correct appearance when on the field during the competition. Open-toed shoes or camouflage clothing, accessories, or archery equipment are not permitted.
- Athletes, team officials, and technicians should wear their national team uniforms and sport shoes having the same appearance as per the division, following the World Archery Rules.

Other Matters of Importance

1. Environment

Team Managers, please instruct your team members to use the litter bins located on the competition and practice fields.

2. Water

The water stations will be located on the competition and practice field.

3. Non-Smoking

- This is a non-smoking event.
- Smoking is forbidden inside public buildings and all competition and training areas, including electronic cigarettes.

4. Mixed Zone and Press Conference

All the Gold Medal winners will be invited for short interviews after the gold medal matches.

5. Hotel Expenses and Internet Access

- The internet access will be free of charge in the rooms and lobbies at the official hotels.
- All other hotel expenses, including laundry and minibar, etc, will be covered by the participants themselves.
- The internet access will be available at the venue free of charge.

Article 3.13.3.1:

An intention to appeal when it might affect the progression of an athlete from one stage of the competition to the next, shall be expressed in writing and lodged with the chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission within five minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever applies. During the Finals of match play rounds, the notice of intent to file an appeal shall be given within five minutes of the end of the match, or prior to the start of the next match, whichever is first.

Article 3.13.8:

Jury decisions shall be minuted and reported to the appellant, the chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission and the organisers.
