Meeting Report

The GNAM ran to the same format as that of previous years, whereby we shot Day 3 first, on the Friday, in the hope that the Double rounds would be better supported.

Entry levels were about the same as last year. 94 Archers shot over the 3 days and again, this year we also invited Archers to shoot the shorter Bristol and National rounds.

At assembly we welcomed all the GNAM first timers individually, with this year about a half of those present were shooting their first GNAM. This was the same as last year, and the year before, so there is clearly some kind of GNAM phenomenon going on here? The total number still remains fairly constant even with a 50% turnover? Clearly Archers are not following my last words "Bring a friend", or should that now be "Encourage that friend to come again!" The meeting was then formally opened by one of the GNAM regulars, Karen Williams shooting the first arrow.

As shooting proceeded, the meeting was sedate and the Judges not necessarily rushing us to and from the targets to score. Ania provided us all with cake and biscuits, although the "Cake Tent" and DOS Tent decided to take a trip across the field on Friday night so the refreshments were hastily moved to the shelter of the pavilion. I think we catered the right amount of cake following a hasty email conversation earlier in the week with Ania about how much to buy. There was plenty left for the work party to tuck into once the Archers had had their fill!!!! Again I spent Friday night Googling some quizzes for us all to do. Identify sweets and flowers as well as a General Knowledge round and a Film and TV bars round. They did get a fair few conversations going as planned. The answers can be found on lanseo.net.

This year we gave out complimentary pin badges to celebrate 165 years of the Grand National Archery Society, as well as box stickers. We hope that you liked them.

Normally I shoot the York on Saturday to allow me to clean silverware Sunday and then setup the presentation table, but as some will know, I didn't shoot the Saturday morning. My slicing my thumb open (See later), the Gazebo incident and it raining, I just couldn't be bothered. Instead I visited every Archer on the field to give them the pin and sticker. However I did join in, in the afternoon, except not on my planned target as there was a bit of left hand right hand scope setup thing going on and there wasn't space for me so I ended up moving to the next available space which was with Patrick Huston. I took great delight in pointing out that I beat him on a couple of ends, but he retorted that on at least one of them he beat me, had we been doing metric scoring!!! It was also interesting to see a proper Robin Hood on an adjacent target where a thinner arrow had gone right down the shaft of the arrow it struck, to the fletchings!

The presentation ceremony took an hour with our Chairman of Judges Brian awarding the prizes.

The opportunity to break records for rounds rarely shot was certainly feature of the meeting and 10 records were claimed. A large number of Roses were also claimed. 34 in total plus 4 3/6 Gold End awards. Well done to all those who claimed!

I must take a moment to thank the volunteers who helped over the 3 days. Mark, David, Jon, Rob and Ania as well as our First Aider, Nash, who I had to call upon on Saturday having sliced the top of my thumb trying to repair one of the Archery GB trollies on Friday morning. The wound opened up again when I had to help deal with the wayward gazebos Saturday morning, so I was upgraded from tissue paper and insulating tape as demonstrated at assembly on Friday to proper plasters and micropore on Saturday!!

Finally Thankyou everyone for coming, your company and field crew help for 3 days.

If you have any thoughts or comments on the meeting, both good or bad please do get in contact. We want to improve on the atmosphere of the event as well as increasing attendance. Its likely that we will send out a survey to all participants, so please take the time to think about your answers and send your replies. It will help shape things moving forward.

So that brings a close to the 171st GNAM for 2026. We look forward to seeing everyone again in 2027. As the Bob Tonkin saying goes, bring a friend. Or two...!!! Or try and encourage that 50% who don't come back the following year, to come back. Let's aim for 150 Archers in 2027!
