This competition is open to Archers who are members of Archery GB or a World Archery affiliated organisation. Crossbows and professional archers are not permitted.

This competition will be shot in two details, with up to two archers per detail, totalling a maximum of four per target. All bow types will use 122cm faces at the first two distances and 10-zone or 6-zone (CUL) 80cm faces thereafter. A combination of foam and straw bosses will be used for this event.

Entrants must declare their Archery GB membership number on the entry form and membership cards will be required when registering on the day. Failure to do so will result in you not being allowed to shoot.

To minimise the risk of undetectable arrows being left on the range, archers are encouraged not to use all-carbon arrows. Archers wishing to use all-carbon arrows are required to identify their equipment to the organisers at registration and event completion. All lost arrows are to be reported asap. No Carbon arrows can be left on the field.

The tournament organiser, WAA, Blandy Jenkins Archers, Llanharan Recreation Ground Trust cannot accept any responsibility for loss, damage, or injury to persons, property, or equipment before, during, or after this tournament, howsoever caused.

GDPR When you enter competitions, the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, and other competitors. For example, target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.

Target lists and results will be sent via email and will be available on lanseo

Under 18s: Must be accompanied at all times by a member of their household who is over 18 and therefore assuming parental responsibility

Dress code: Archery GB regulations, as shown in Rule 307, will apply.

Drug Testing: Record Status Tournaments are subject to drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples **MUST** comply. If refused, the refusal will be treated as a positive result. Archers must sign the form to signify their consent - entries for Archers aged under 18 must be acknowledged by a parent/guardian to signify their consent to their children being drug tested if approached.

First Aid Kits will NOT be available for minor injuries, please ensure you have any items you feel essential with you

Photography: Any individual wishing to take photographs at the event must register with the tournament organiser on the day. A consent form will be available on the day.

Car Parking: Ample free car parking on site. **Please note there is strictly no camping allowed on site.**

Smoking: Smoking is not permitted indoors at the Llanharan Welfare Grounds.

Litter: Ample bins will be available, please do not leave any litter on the field.

Drinks: Please bring your own reusable cups for tea, coffees etc

Food: A separate pre-order form for food will be sent out to all entrants a few weeks prior to the event.

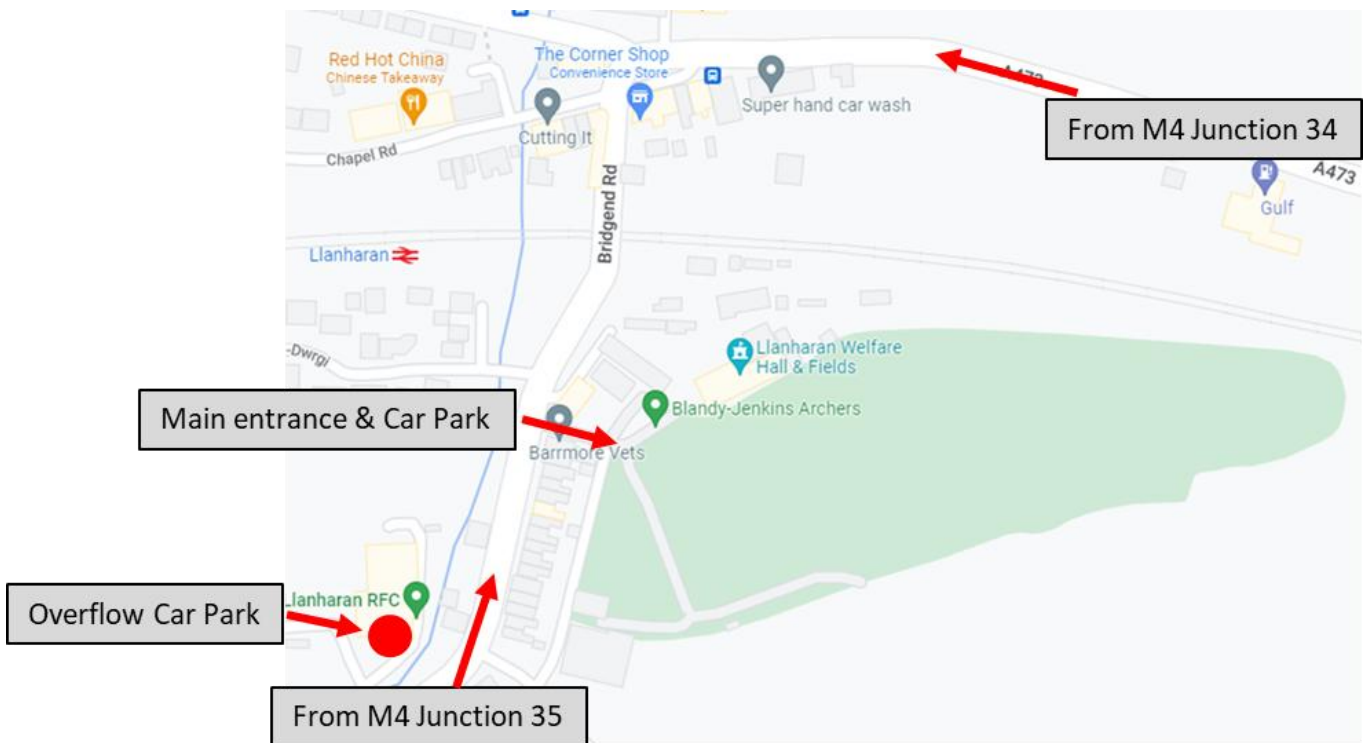
From Junction 34 on the M4

At the motorway roundabout, take the A4119 towards Llantrisant. At the next roundabout, turn left onto the A473 for Bridgend. Stay on the A473 following signs for Bridgend / Llanharan.

Once in Llanharan, the field is the 1st turning left over the railway bridge.

From Junction 35 on the M4

Follow signs for A473 North 'Pencoed & Llantrisant'. Follow Pencoed by-pass (dual carriageway) to Pencoed College roundabout. From here follow signs for A473 Llantrisant or Talbot Green, until you come to Llanharan then follow the schematic below for shoot location



PARKING

There are plenty of parking spaces in 3 locations available to the shoot; two are on the grounds and the third 300yds away. There is limited space allocated for disabled archers/spectators please indicate on your application form if you require one of these spaces.
