Rounds	Double World Archery 70m (Recurve and Longbow) Double World Archery 50m (Compound and Barebow) Double World Archery 60m (Masters) Junior rounds available on request – please email tournament organiser There will be four archers per target shooting in two details. Six arrow, timed ends shot in 4 minutes. Recurve and Longbow archers will shoot on a full-sized 122cm face. Barebow archers will shoot on a full-sized 122cm face and Compound archers will shoot on a cut-down 80cm face with 6-zone scoring.
Record status & drug testing	This competition is World Record Status for both days. Archers competing at record status competitions may be drug tested. Competitors who are approached to give a sample must comply. Refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result. Parents/guardians of juniors must tick the relevant box on the entry form giving consent for juniors (those under 18 years old) to be drug tested if approached.
Awards	Medals will be awarded to archers shooting in their correct round appropriate to their age and gender, following DWAA medal policy. Master (50+) and Junior awards given. Recurve (3 archers) and Compound (2 archers) teams subject to entry.

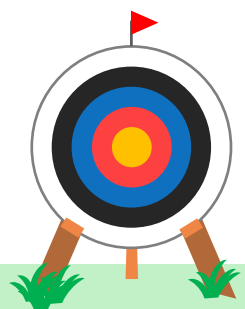
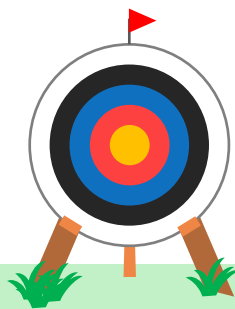
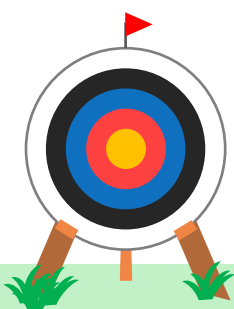

All carbon arrows	As this is a multi-purpose field shared with a school all arrows must be found. Archers must indicate on their entry form if they plan to shoot all carbon arrows. This assists in us knowing where all carbon arrows may be lost so they can be found easier.
