



West Midlands v East Midlands



Team Event

- At the **end of the AGB900 round** we will be trailing a new **Team Match**.
- Each team manager will select 8 archers (Seniors) / 3 Archers (Juniors) to take part in a team match consisting of:
 - 1 Open team; and 1 Women team and 1 Mixed Junior Team
- Each **Senior** team consists of - 1 Compound, 1 Recurve 1 Barebow, and 1 Longbow archer (and this is the order it is shot in)
- The **Mixed Junior** team consists of - 1 Compound, 1 Recurve and 1 Barebow archer (and shot in that order). The mixed team must have both genders
- The Senior team will shoot at a single distance of **50m**, whilst the Juniors will shoot at **40m**
- Each archer will shoot **2 arrows** per set, and needs to step on and off the line after each shot.
- An archer only comes to the shooting line once the previous archer has shot their arrow.
- The format will be '**set scoring**' - 2 points for a win and 1 for a draw; first team to **5 points** achieve the "**bonus points**"
- If the scores are tied after 4 sets then the winner will be decided on TOTAL AGGREGATE POINTS from the 4 sets
- **25 bonus points** will be awarded to each of the winning teams, and these points are added to the overall team points gained from the main competition
- **No** timings will be used as this may be the first time archers have shot a team head-to-head match.
- Scoring will be on **paper score sheets** only.
