Dear Archer,

We are looking forward to welcoming you to Meriden for the WMAS Championships/EMAS Match. Please find below a few reminders to ensure that you have an enjoyable shoot. Your support with the following will be very much appreciated:

- Please do not arrive before 7.45am. Parking space is limited within our grounds. Therefore, when our parking on site is full, space is available outside the ground on the road. Please make sure you do not park on the public footpath adjacent to the main road. Whilst shooting is in progress, please do not leave our ground by car or on foot. Wait for a break in shooting so archers are not distracted.
- Tents can be pitched from 6pm on Saturday 29 August 2026. Please be aware that the day before we will be hosting 140 archers at Meriden for our late-summer WA720 H2H so no tents can be pitched until that concludes. Please do not pitch on the hatched areas.
- Please check the Target List when you arrive just in case there has been any last-minute changes.
- Anyone wishing to use video or photographic equipment at the tournament must register prior to the shoot starting at the Judges' Hut.
- Equipment inspection will be from 8.15am by bow style along the shooting line on the main field. This will also act as registration for the event.
- Jo Orbell is our Chair of Judges. The rest of the judging team are Susan Richards, Andy Stanford, Sharon Gray, Luke Wilson and Peter Brookes. Thank you for officiating. It is really appreciated.
- Assembly will be 8.45am followed by official practice.
- Refreshments consisting of hot and cold drinks, pastries and cakes will be served all day in the Club House. Please bring a reusable cup/bottle to help save waste. No hot food will be available. Payment is by cash or card.
- Don't forget a water bottle, sun cream and hat. We will provide buckets of water for wetting towels in if the weather is warm and sunny. Bottles can be refilled in the clubhouse kitchen.
- Please help the results team by making sure scoresheets are filled in clearly, added up correctly and returned asap once complete. Please return PDAs to the shooting line after every end.
- Medals will be presented asap after the completion of the afternoon's shooting.

Finally, we will have Meriden Archery Club members volunteering throughout the day to support the smooth running of the tournament for you. If you have any queries prior Sunday or on the day, please do not hesitate to contact me.
