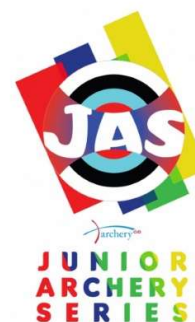




JAS Finals 2026

Dear Archer,

Congratulations on making it to this year's JAS Finals. Please find below a few reminders to ensure that you have an enjoyable shoot on the day. There are 100 archers registered to shoot so your support with the following will be much appreciated:

- Please do not arrive before 7.30am. Parking space is limited within our grounds. Therefore, when our parking on site is full, space is available outside the ground on the road. Do not park on the footpath. Please do not leave our ground by car or on foot whilst shooting is in progress. Wait for a break in shooting so archers are not distracted.
- Tents can be pitched from 5-7pm the night before. Please do not pitch on the hatched areas. There will be practice as soon as the field is set up which will last until 7.00pm. No overnight camping is allowed.
- Registration will be in the Club House from 7.45am. Please register as soon as you arrive just in case the Target List has changed. As a little reward for making the finals, there is a small memento of the day for every archer taking part.
- Anyone wishing to use video or photographic equipment at the tournament must register prior to the shoot starting at the Judges Hut.
- Equipment inspection will be from 7.45am in front of the Judges Hut on the main field.
- Jo Orbell is our Chair of Judges for the day supported by Andy Stanford, Peter Brookes, Luke Wilson, and Karen Macey. Thank you for officiating. It is really appreciated.
- Assembly will be 8.30am followed by practice at 8.45am.
- Refreshments consisting of hot and cold drinks, pastries and cakes will be served all day in the Club House. Please bring a reusable cup/bottle to help save waste. No hot food will be available. Payment is by cash or card.
- Please help our scorers by making sure scoresheets are filled in clearly, added up correctly and returned asap once complete.
- Medals will be presented for the finals asap after the completion of the H2H matches followed by presentations to the 2026 overall JAS Champions.

Finally, we will have many Meriden Archery Club members volunteering throughout the day to support the smooth running of the tournament for you. If you have any queries prior to Saturday or on the day, please do not hesitate to contact me.
